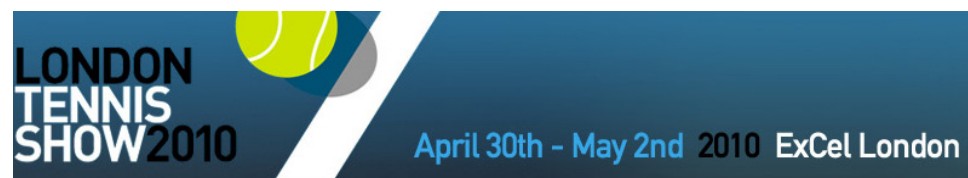
One Universally Accepted Scheme

The Tennis Racquet Specialist Scheme is an education and certification programme for shops and teaching pros benefitting the buying public.

TRS Certified Stringers are recognised experts in this field and a real asset to British tennis.

Consumers are able to seek out TRS Certified Stringers from the directory in The Tennis Book as well as on the TIA UK website at www.tiauk.org, certain in the knowledge that they will receive the best available advice and service for their tennis racquet equipment.

The scheme is featured in the London Golf & Tennis Show where stringing demonstrations are featured and questions answered.





- It costs £125 to participate in a Workshop and the price includes the certification test, usually taken one month later.
- It also includes one year's membership of the TIA UK as a TRS Non-Voting Member that will be upgraded to Certified Stringer status on graduation, in addition to a year's electronic membership of the European Racquet Stringers Association.
- Certified Stringers appear in the online TRS Directory as well as in The Tennis Book to promote their skills as recognised qualified specialists.
- They also receive copies of both The Tennis Book and the TIA UK's newspaper, Tennis Outlook, as well as RacquetTech, the ERSA's own publication.

2010 WORKSHOPS

The TRS Scheme is proving a great way for racquet stringers to be trained and certified as the acknowledged experts in the field of racquet technology and therefore a real asset to British tennis.
